**HOW TO BE PLANTED IN GOD!**

We don't live in a secure world. The economy is uncertain, the fear of terrorist attacks, the threat of our country's collapse and global warming. The Psalmist tells us three truths that needs to be planted in our lives. The first truth is, "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble," psalm 46:1.

That's where we can find true security and peace. Our security is in God, not in this world. When the economy collapses, wars break out, natural disasters destroy our homes, government fails, or our health deteriorates, God is the only place we can find security. Our world, with all its advancements in education, technology and science, is no safer today than it was thousands of years ago.

The second truth we need to have planted deeply in our lives is our security that comes from our faith not from our circumstance. In Psalm 46:5 the Psalmist says God is within the city, and therefore she will not fall. And in verse 7, "the Lord Almighty is with us...". His faith is in the presence of God, and that gives him hope and security. God wants us to depend on Him.

The third truth we need to have planted deeply in our lives is that our security is in Eternity, not in the present. This world is not our home. If you are looking only at the present circumstance you will be shaken, but if your life is grounded in eternity you will stand firm.

The security you must have is the security of God Himself.

## Butterfinger Banana Cake

Banana and Nestlé Butterfinger candy add to the flavor and moistness of this delicious cake.

- 1 package (18.25 oz.) yellow cake mix
- 2 medium, ripe bananas, mashed (about 1 cup total)
- 3 (2.1 oz ea) NESTLE® BUTTERFINGER® Candy Bar, chopped, divided
- 1 container (16 oz.) prepared white frosting

PREHEAT oven to 350° F. Grease and flour 13 x 9-inch baking pan.

PREPARE cake mix batter according to package directions; stir in banana and 3/4 cup chopped Butterfinger. Pour into prepared pan.

BAKE for 40 to 50 minutes or until wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool completely in pan on wire rack.

FROST cake; sprinkle with remaining chopped Butterfinger.

Makes 12 servings.

## Apple, Asian Pear, and Toasted Walnut Haroseth

- 1 1/4 cups walnut halves
- 1 Granny Smith apple, peeled, cored, cut into 1/3-inch cubes
- 1 Asian pear, peeled, cored, cut into 1/3-inch cubes
- 3 tablespoons sweet Passover wine
- 2 tablespoons (or more) honey
- 1 teaspoon finely grated orange peel
- 3/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- Chopped fresh mint

Stir walnuts in heavy small skillet over medium heat until lightly browned and fragrant, about 5 minutes. Cool and chop nuts; place in medium bowl. Add apple, pear, wine, 2 tablespoons honey, orange peel, and cinnamon. Stir to blend, adding more honey, if desired. DO AHEAD: Can be made 4 hours ahead. Let stand at room temperature. Toss to blend and drain before continuing.

Sprinkle haroseth with mint; serve.
