MEANING OF EASTER:

March 23rd is Easter Sunday. Do we truly know the meaning of Easter? Ask any child: Easter is Easter bunnies and eggs. Ask any mother: Easter is new clothes. Ask any dad: Easter is a good dinner.

Is the preacher the only one who will respond with Easter is the celebration of Jesus' resurrection!? We have turned from an empty tomb to an Easter egg and the symbol of the Easter bunny has replaced the cross. Has the real meaning of Easter escaped us?

The angel at the tomb told the women, He is not here: for He is risen, Matt. 28:6.

If Easter means anything, it means Jesus Christ is Lord. He has authority over life, death and salvation. The Scriptures stress that Jesus actually rose from the dead. The apostle Paul declared this fact as the basis of his personal faith and listed as proof many eyewitnesses of Christ's resurrection, I Cor. 15:5-8.

The empty tomb convinced Jesus' disciples of His lordship. For He was declared to be the Son of God with power, by the resurrection from the dead, Rom 1:4. If His body had remained in Joseph's family plot, another prophet would have passed this way, but no Savior.

The message of Easter is that Jesus is alive. Christ is our living Lord.

Strawberry Cobbler II

- 1/2 cup white sugar
 - 1 tablespoon cornstarch
 - 1 cup water
 - 3 cups sliced fresh strawberries
 - 2 tablespoons margarine
-
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
 - 1/4 cup packed dark brown sugar
 - 1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
 - 1/2 teaspoon salt
 - 3 tablespoons butter
 - 3/4 cup half-and-half cream
-
- 1/4 cup margarine
 - 1/4 cup packed dark brown sugar
1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F (200 degrees C)
Grease a 2 quart baking dish with margarine.
 2. In a medium saucepan, combine sugar, cornstarch, water, and strawberries. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until thick and hot. Pour mixture into the prepared baking dish. Dot with 2 tablespoons margarine.
 3. In a bowl, combine flour, 1/4 cup brown sugar, baking powder, and salt. Blend in the 3 tablespoons butter. Stir in cream. Mixture should be soft. When you spoon dough onto the berries, it will probably sink to the bottom. Just try to spread as well as you can. Don't worry, it comes out good.
 4. Bake for about 20 to 25 minutes in the preheated oven. When the cobbler is almost done, mix the 1/4 cup margarine and 1/4 cup brown sugar, and heat them in a saucepan or in the microwave (whichever is easier for you). When the topping is heated, brush it on the top of the cobbler and bake for another 5 to 10 minutes.
